Required by: Title 8 CCR 3400 & 1512 and other California General Industry Safety Orders.

Target Audience: Medical Emergency Response Team (MERT) members who respond to first aid and CPR emergencies.

Duration: Basic course is 3- 4 hours. Advanced courses from 8 - 40 hours.

Refresher: Every three years.

BLOODBORNE PATHOGENES

This course is aimed at First Responders in industrial settings who respond to medical emergencies. Medical Emergency Response Teams (MERT) must be trained on how to protect themselves from Bloodborne Pathogens. Training topics include: Epidemiology of HIV & Hepatitis; Universal Precautions, Engineering Controls; Work Practice Controls; Personal Protective Equipment (PPE); Proper Handling and Disposal of Regulated Waste; Housekeeping; Immunization and a review of your companies Exposure Control Plan. This course should be offered in conjunction with both the First Aid and CPR courses.



Required by: Cal OSHA §5095 - 5100 and Fed OSHA .1910.130.

Target Audience: Medical Emergency Response Team (MERT) members who respond to first aid and CPR emergencies.

Duration: Basic course is 3- 4 hours. Advanced courses from 8 - 40 hours.

Refresher: Annually
